

Description of action:

To design and create a prayer space in our Courtyard for all pupils to be able to spend time in prayer and reflection on their own or with friends during break times and lunch time (Living simply)

Faith Input:

Pupils will have the opportunity to explore a variety of resources e.g. CAFOD, Mlni VInnies, Catholic Social Teaching to support with the creation of the new prayer area. The focus of the area will be Creation, linking with Catholic Social Teaching 'Stewardship of God's Creation'.

Education input:

The opportunity for prayer will build a stronger realtionship with God and enable the children to live out our school mission 'We love and learn by growing in friendship with Jesus'. By spending this quiet time in prayer and reflection it can help with children's wellbeing, making them feel more positive, happier and give them a positive outlook.

Description of action:

Criteria for live simply: To take action towards living a simpler lifestyle including slowing down and finding time to pray and reflect, refusing and reducing on what we consume, spending more time on the simpler things in life including reflective time with family and friends, time in nature.

Brief description of main action:

To create a link with a local care home. Pupils will send cards and letters to the residents. Some pupils will visit and spend some time with the residents, talking and playing games with them. The choir will visit and perform for the residents
