## Class Saint

Lucia of Syracuse, also known as St. Lucy, or St. Lucia, was a Christian martyr who died during the persecution of Christians during the Roman Empire. St. Lucy chose to be a Christian at a time when Christianity was illegal. She gave up her riches and devoted her life to the poor. After resisting the advances of a Roman soldier, St. Lucy was denounced as a Christian and brutally executed. She is one of eight women, who along with the Blessed Virgin Mary, are commemorated by name in the Canon of the Mass.

Lucy's Latin name Lucia shares a root [luc-] with the Latin word for light, lux. Hence St. Lucy is the patron saint of the blind and those with eye-trouble.






